3. Please make sure group participants are aware of appropriate behaviour including
 - Not touching the sculpture or exhibits
 - Not running anywhere in the park or galleries
 - Not eating or drinking except in the designated picnic areas
 - Not depositing litter anywhere except in the bins provided
4. Permission is granted for group participants to take photographs at Roche Court on the understanding that photographs are for educational purposes only and will not be published. No photographs may be taken of the main house which is a private home.
