ARTiculation Discovery Days are designed to **develop and support students' understanding and engagement with art.** During this one-day workshop students will:

- explore the works of the artist Bethan Lloyd Worthington through **personal observation, discussion and primary research**
- be encouraged to **think independently, analyse information, ask informed questions**
- learn how to **conquer nerves, physically prepare, and successfully deliver a presentation to large audiences**
- meet with and **interview art world professionals**

At the end of the day each student will **deliver their research and personal responses in short group presentations** to the workshop leaders and their fellow student investigators.

The day will focus on Bethan Lloyd Worthington's exhibition, *Shell-Lit Siambr*. Through installations of ceramics, drawings and textiles, artist Bethan Lloyd Worthington explores personal and prehistoric connections between bodies and the landscape. The exhibition looks at the particular pull of place in the context of Canterbury and offers objects as portals into landscape, as symbols of pilgrimage, and as holders of memory.

ARTiculation supports the national Arts Award initiative for both Silver and Gold (gaining up to 16 UCAS points), the EPQ, the Duke of Edinburgh Award, and UCAS personal statements
