- be encouraged to **think independently, analyse information, ask informed questions**
- learn how to **conquer nerves, physically prepare**, and **successfully deliver a presentation** to large audiences
- meet with and **interview art world professionals**

At the end of the day each student will **deliver their research and personal responses in short group presentations** to the workshop leaders and their fellow student investigators.
